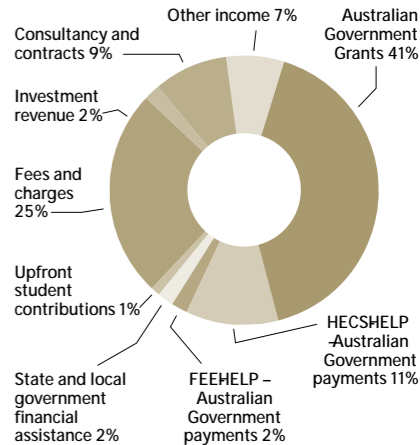


SUMMARY OF FINANCIAL INFORMATION

As per the financial statements, the University recorded a consolidated deficit of \$15.5m for 2016. This compares to a consolidated surplus of \$58.5m in 2015.
